

NC Locksmith Licensing Board Minutes
September 1, 2010
Raleigh, NC

Call to Order: Mrs. Hampton called the meeting to order and asked that Mr. Storie read the Ethics Awareness Statement. Mr. Bright reported that he might have a conflict of interest with a case in the Ethics Committee.

Approval of Meeting Minutes: The minutes from the August 9th and July 14th meeting were reviewed. Mr. Bright moved to approve the minutes, Mr. Storie seconded.

Treasurer's Report: Mr. Wilson had some questions about the 3-year budget cycle. Mr. Storie motioned to approve, Mr. Wilson seconded, and the Treasurer's Report was accepted.

Examination and Continuing Education Committee: Mr. Bright reported that after meeting outside of the regular meeting, the first round of "Guinea Pigs" would be provided by the NCLA in November and the examination board would be ready to do the first round of testing in February. Mr. Bright reported that there are 200+ questions on the exam, yet only 185 "count." The test is very light on specialized locksmiths. A new computerized system would level the playing field. Mr. Storie said he was taking a one-hour training course tomorrow to learn the software. Mr. Bright reported that the cost would be around \$300.

New Business: Randolph Cloud spoke to the Association members present on items they want to consider to seek in the coming Legislative Session in January.

Mr. Boone drafted a letter which he said would probably be much more effective at keeping locksmiths from "falling through the cracks."
