

**NORTH CAROLINA LOCKSMITH LICENSING BOARD  
MAY 24, 2004  
RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA**

**Attendance: Tom Campion, Chair, Chris Boykin, Neal Ensley, Dennis Green, Joe McCann, Greg Wright, Anna Bridgers.**

**Guests in Attendance: Steve Bright, Bly Hall.**

**The Board meeting was called to order by Tom Campion. Neal then read the Ethics Awareness and Conflict of Interest Statement. No one indicated any conflicts.**

**The first order of business was to approve the April 5, 2004 minutes. Joe made a motion to approve the minutes as prepared by Anna. Chris seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.**

**The next order of business was the Treasurer's Report. Since Laura was not present at the meeting, Chris made a motion to delay reviewing the April 2004 financial report until the next Board meeting. Joe seconded this motion and the motion carried.**

**Tom Campion reported on Document Creation in Laura's absence. Tom told the Board members that he was impressed that a large number of institutional locksmiths are licensed. Tom then asked the Board members about their progress on the watchlist. Everyone stated that they did receive the watchlist, but little progress has been made up to this point.**

**Neal then asked the Board about the status of the contested case. Anna told Neal that the applicant was given the opportunity to come to today's Board meeting to present additional oral argument. Neal felt that the applicant should have until the close of the Board meeting to appear for this purpose.**

**Dennis inquired if the return of one's \$100 license fee from the Board is the same thing as withdrawing one's application. Bly said that the return of the \$100 license fee to an applicant is entirely different than withdrawing one's application.**

**The next report concerned the Examination Committee. Tom asked the Board members when another test should be administered. Steve Bright said that the Board can administer the test on August 6<sup>th</sup> at the next NCLA meeting, which is being held in Charlotte. Steve said that he would be in contact with Laura about scheduling this.**

**There was nothing to report on behalf of the Rules Committee.**

**The Board members then took a break to eat lunch.**

When the Board convened after lunch, no one had anything to report under New Business.

Chris then presented on behalf of the Standards Committee. Chris made a motion to accept all approved locksmiths for licensure, and Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The next order of business was scheduling the next Board meeting. Joe made a motion that the next meeting be held on July 12<sup>th</sup> in Greensboro. Greg seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

The final order of business concerned the contested case. Neal read G.S. 150B-40(e) about the petitioner being granted an opportunity to make an oral argument before the Board. Neal said that seeing as how no petitioner appeared to present such arguments, the Board should proceed and decide whether or not to adopt the Administrative Law Judge's decision.

Bly then reviewed the official record of the proceedings in the case with the Board members. Dennis made a motion to adopt the Standards Committee's decision and the Administrative Law Judge's decision to deny the applicant a locksmith license. Neal seconded the motion and the motion carried. It was noted that the Board's final decision needs to be communicated to the applicant.

With no further business, Greg made a motion to adjourn. Joe seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned.
